All the notified Sub-Districts / Xomo Zilla will also be covered within the original districts as mentioned above.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. All Addl. Chief Engineers will conduct the review of progress of all the ongoing schemes including the delayed PMKSY-SMI (AIBP) projects and submit schematic progress report to Government under intimation to Chief Engineer, Irrigation. They will also review the O & M works of all the Divisions under their Zonal jurisdictions.
- 2. They will organize Virtual Meetings with the concerned EEs / SEs and formulate a strategic road-map to achieve the target of completion. The projects with more than one year delay have to be completed mandatorily by 31st December, 2025.
- 3. The Addl. Chief Engineers will also review the status of budget implementation of

the respective works divisions and take necessary action for 100% utilization of the allocated budget during the Financial year. They may also suggest the requirement of additional budget for completion of the work as per the current status and shall identify new proposals for prioritization/inclusion in the next financial year.

- 4. They will also take necessary action for capacity building of man power of the Divisions and also for effective utilization of man power resources including the available assets created. They will make an inventory protocol on the performing as well as non-performing assets of the divisions and make suitable recommendations as deemed fit, to Government for taking needful action. This exercise shall also include devising an appropriate mechanism to evaluate the assets lying in the divisions which are either unserviceable or not accounted for in the books of record, so that the same may be accounted and properly taken care of for disposal and effective utilization by other divisions by transfer as the case may be.
- 5. All Addl CEs will frequently review the process of mandatory uploading of Data in IPMS (<u>ino Irrigaton</u>) by the AEEs/EEs of the Divisions in consultation with concerned SEs under their respective Zonal Jurisdiction. The SEs shall be made responsible to put in place a robust system for regular upload of all data by the AEEs/EEs in IPMS.
- 6. The Addl CEs will present the status of progress of schemes within their jurisdiction as and when review meetings are taken by Higher Authorities in Government.
- 7. The undersigned shall review the overall progress of the ongoing works fortnightly with the respective Addl. Chief Engineers.

This comes into force with immediate effect.

This supersedes all earlier Office Orders issued in this regard.
