A determined farmer from Barpeta district's Paragon Village in Assam shared how the PMKSY scheme changed his life for good. He narrated his harrowing experiences and tough times that he endured irrigating his farmland as he dealt with acute water scarcity issues in his area. At one time he almost went bankrupt.

But, with the announcement of the PMKSY scheme, his life took a pleasant turn. After availing a Tubewell under the PMKSY scheme, he now produces 1.2 tonne of wheat per bigha in his 10 bighas cultivable land and earns good profit from sale proceeds.

Earlier, he used to cultivate 0.5 tonne of wheat per bigha before availing the scheme which was a loss-making affair for him.

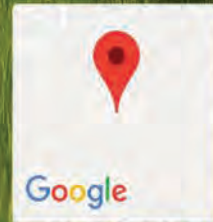
"With the help of this Scheme, I have constructed an irrigation tank and with connected pipes, I can water my farmlands well. My harvest is better and I am earning more", says Rajib Das.



Another farmer Jiten Chandra Das of Bhatarbari Village, Barpeta District of Assam, engaged in rice and vegetable cultivation in his 5 bighas land rued about how his low agriculture produce dampened his income.

Things changed when PMKSY was launched.

Before the introduction of PMKSY, Jiten could only produce around 360 kg rice per bigha in his land. After availing the benefit under PMKSY, he started producing around 600 kg rice per bigha and his income has gone up subsequently. No wonder, he is now all praise for the scheme and happily engaged in his farming.

Bongaigaon

Meet Mr. Dilip Kumar Ray of Borpothar village in Bongaigaon district, Assam whose dream has blossomed into reality after the introduction of PMKSY scheme.

In his 20 bighas land, Mr. Ray cultivates both rice and vegetables, but didn't yield much. With PMKSY, he shared that his rice production increases to around 30%.

Now, he has produced 150 quintals of ginger too and has earned a good profit. He next plans to cultivate cauliflower and PMKSY is set to subsidise the seed cost this time too. He has also been provided with a sprinkler system under the Scheme.
