Barak Valley

The Barak Valley is located in the southern region of the state of Assam. The major city of the valley is Silchar. The region is named after the Barak River. The Barak valley consists of three administrative districts of Assam - namely Cachar, Karimganj, and Hailakandi.

According to the 2011 Indian census, Barak valley had a population of 3,624,599.

Tea, oil, and natural gas of this region act as a major economic boost for the state of Assam.

A total of 7 Divisions of Irrigation falls under this district. PMKSY implementation in all districts of Barak valley, falling under Phase II, is still in progress and is steadily moving towards 100% implementation of the scheme.
