Nothing can beat the happiness of a farmer who has achieved a three-fold rise in crop production. Such is the case of Mr. Nizam Uddin Mazumder of Kanchanpur village who claims that his crop yield has risen three times after receiving proper irrigation water for his farming under the PMKSY scheme.

Earlier, he used to cultivate only one or two varieties of vegetables per season. But now, Mr. Mazumder has been able to diversify his farming activities and has set out to grow Potatoes, Farashi Pulses, Tomatoes and Rice. This in turn has increased his income, thus, substantially increasing his standard of living.

Mr. Dalim Uddin Laskar of Hailakandi District heaped a huge sigh of relief after reaping the benefits of PMKSY-HKPP Scheme which was made available to him by the Irrigation Department, Govt of Assam.

Laskar was quite sure of quitting farming as lack of proper & timely irrigation facilities and insufficient rainfall had severely affected his production, causing him to suffer financial losses over the last few years. Though sceptical in the beginning, Mr Laskar gathered courage and had a tubewell installed under PMKSY in his farmland.

Now, he cultivates a wide variety of crops & vegetables including Rice, Potato, Tomato and Farashi Pulses. His 7 bighas of land now yields 120-150 Kgs of potato per bigha which yielded 40-50 Kgs of potato per bigha earlier.



KARIMGANJ

Failed crops, low income had become a consistent affair in the life of Mr. Akab Uddin of Karimganj District. He drew ground water using a petrol-run motor in order to irrigate his farmland. The crops that he cultivated earned him a meagre income due to high cost of production. Despite maintaining a hectic daily schedule and giving it all the fields, Mr Laskar misfortune did not seem to end.

But, with the installation of a solar tubewell under the PMKSY scheme, greenery returned to his farmland. Now, his entire 14 bighas land is well irrigated and receives sufficient water. His vegetable cultivation increased, income increased, and above all his lifestyle changed for good.

Sanjoy Namasudra is another ideal paddy cultivator of Karimganj District. Insufficient rainfall and lack of proper irrigation water affected his production to a great extent. With less production, he could not make up for his financial needs. But his gloomy days were soon to be over. His decision of installing an Electrical Pump that he availed through PMKSY, proved to be a game changer for him. His production increased subsequently from 300kg rice per bigha to 700-800kg rice per bigha.
